You are cordially invited to the 2012 Annual Dinner of the Cambridge University Hare and Hounds, and to the Roman Road Run which precedes it, to be held on Saturday 17th March 2012 in Cambridge. I would like to take this opportunity to extend the invite to all members of Cambridge and Coleridge.

The annual Roman Road Run is a 9.5 mile handicap race along a Roman Road, starting from outside the city and finishing at Wandlebury Country Park. This year, the coach to the start line will leave the Wilberforce Road athletics track at 12.30pm, with the race beginning at approximately 1.15pm. After the race, the coach will return to the athletics track, and there will be a presentation and refreshments available from 3.30pm.

The Annual Dinner this year is being held at Jesus College. Pre-dinner drinks will be served from 6:30pm, and dinner will be served at 7.30pm. The menu is as follows:

Roasted Quails Breast with Parmesan Polenta and Roasted Figs, served with orange port glaze
Vegetarian: Pears with Roquefort Cheese, served with rocket and pickled walnut salad

Served with White and Red wine

Herb Crusted Roast Rack of Norfolk Lamb, with a pea puree and a rosemary and port jus
Vegetarian: Baked Mushrooms with Spinach, Brie and Walnuts

Spiced Winter Fruit Crumble, served with a fresh custard cream sauce (seasonal fruit)

Served with Port

The cost of the meal with drinks is £35, which includes sparkling wine at the reception, wine with your meal, and port after dinner. A non-drinking ticket costs £28, and includes orange juice.
